Spoilt for choice, a hungry omnivore could do no better than The Hunter, a mouth-watering mass of bacon, sausage, eggs how you like them (mine were poached to gooey perfection), meaty mushrooms, well-crisped hash brown and a lovely tomato relish. Service can be a bit hit-and-miss, but the meals are generous and well executed. Friends of those lower down the food chain?
